




## A Note To Parents

Use the handrail to get on and off the bus.




My pals and I stay in our seats until the bus stops. Name three friends you like to sit with:



Always talk quietly on the bus. Never scream.




Don't leave books and trash in the aisle.

## Remember Rudy's Rules

- 1. Always obey your bus driver.

- 6. Always talk quietly on the bus. Never scream.
- 7. Don't leave books and trash in the aisle.
- 8. Keep hands, arms and head inside the bus.
- 9. Don't play with the emergency door.
- 10. When approaching or leaving your bus, if you must cross the street, always cross in front of the bus where the driver can see you.
